

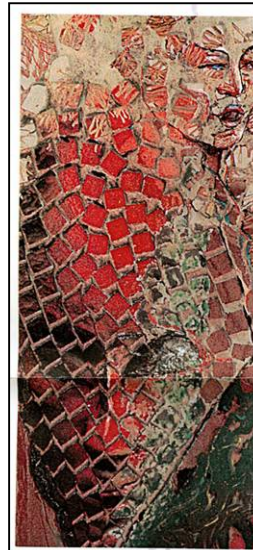

Comedy of the Year in 1988.

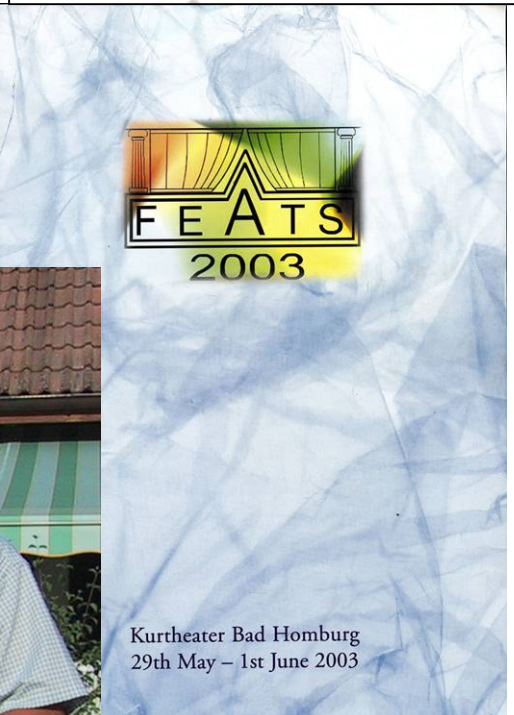
